

ROUTE RAMON LLULL IN MAJORCA

Lullian places in Mallorca

1. Monastery of La Real (Palma)

265 and 1274 Ramon Llull retired to the monastery to study and wrote there his first books. EMT Bus: Porta de Sant Antoni - Son Espanyol (Line 9).

2. Puig de Randa and Sactuary of Cura (Algaida)

Around 1262 Ramon Llull lived as a hermit in a cave and experienced the illumination that would make him write the Ars. TIB Bus: Can Pastilla - Cura (Line 459); Last stop (Carretera PMV-5018).

3. Monastery of Miramar (Valldemossa)

In 1276 Ramon Llull founded a school to teach the monks who lived there Arabic and the Ars method to convert infidels. TIB Bus: Palma - Valldemossa - Port de Sóller (Line 210); get off in Son Gallard (Carretera C-710).

4. Santa Margalida Church (Palma)

Around 1263 he heard a sermon about Saint Francis that convinced him to change his life. Carrer de Sant Miquel, 69.

5. Sant Miquel Church (Palma)

Above the Gothic portal there is a figure of Ramon Llull (1398). Inside the church there is a Baroque chapel dedicated to Llull. Carrer de Sant Miquel, 21.

6. Plaça Major (Palma)

A stone plaque marks the place where Ramon Llull's birth place used to be in 1232. North corner of the square, between two arches.

7. Santa Eulàlia Church (Palma)

According to the legend, young Ramon Llull came into the temple pursuing a girl who ended up showing him a breast affected by cancer. Tile with an image of Ramon Llull in Carrer de l'Església de Santa Eulàlia, 1.

8. Palma City Hall (Palma)

Iconography of Ramon Llull: painting of his funeral (Miquel Bestard), bust (Llorenç Rosselló) and portrait (Ricard Anckerman). Plaça de Cort, 1.

9. Estudi General Lul·lià (Palma)

University that dedicated its first lecture to the study of Ramon Llull (1959). Exterior tile with an image of Llull. Carrer de Sant Roc, 4.

10. Palau March (Palma)

The library of the Bartolomé March Foundation includes the bibliographic archive of Maioricensis Schola Lullistica and other lullian manuscripts. Carrer del Palau Reial, 18.

11. Paseo Sagrera (Palma)

Huge monument erected in 1967 in honour of Ramon Llull. This bronze statue was created by Horacio de Eguía. At the corner of Avinguda d'Antoni Maura.

12. Majorca Cathedral (Palma)

On the main façade of La Seu, on the left hand side, there is a big figure of Ramon Llull. Further lullian iconography in the chapels of Sant Sebastià, Puríssima and Sagrat Cor. Carrer del Palau Reial.

13. Museum of Mallorca (Palma)

Above the main stairs hangs a figurehead that belonged to the ship *Lulio*. It is a work by Ricard Anckerman. Inside the museum there is a Gothic predella that depicts Ramon Llull preaching to Muslims. Carrer de la Portella, 5.

14. Lullian Archaeological Society (Palma)

This society was founded in 1880 for the recovery of Ramon Llull's figure and work and for the study and conservation of Majorca's heritage. There you can find the lullian library Jeroni Rosselló. Carrer de Monti-sion, 9.

15. Diocesan Library of Mallorca (Palma)

It includes several of Ramon Llull's manuscripts (such as the *Book of Contemplation in God* and the *Tree of Love Philosophy*) and other valuable lullian documents. Carrer de Calders, 2.

16. La Sapiència School (Palma)

It was founded in 1629 to promote Llull's doctrines. Above the portal there is a relief with lullian motifs and, in the interior courtyard, there is a sculpture of Llull (1929). Plaça de Sant Jeroni, 1.

17. Casa de Cultura (Palma)

Above the windows there are bas-reliefs that evoke the seven Liberal Arts. The first one (Rhetoric) and the second one (Geometry) present figures of Ramon Llull. Carrer de Ramon Llull, 3.

18. Basilica of Sant Francesc (Palma)

In one of the chapels located on the left hand side of the head of the basilica there is the Gothic sepulchre with Ramon Llull's remains, a work by Francesc Sagrera (1487). Entrance via Sant Francesc School, located in Plaça de Sant Francesc, 7.

19. IES Ramon Llull (Palma)

In the courtyard there is a monument with a sculpture of Ramon Llull after which the high school was named in 1936. Avinguda de Portugal, 2.

20. General Optica (Palma)

This store has inside a beautiful mural that evokes Ramon Llull's "ladder of understanding", a work by Josep Maria Subirachs (1966). Avinguda de Jaume III, 14.
